





Race/Ethnicity


Of all female clients who provided race/ethnicity information, **61.0%** were **Black/African American** and **19.5%** were **Hispanic/Latino**.



Medical

Of female clients who received core medical services in 2014:

- **82.4%** were **retained in care**.*
- **80.1%** were **virally suppressed**.**



Poverty

72.5% of female clients were **living at or below 100%** of the federal poverty level; **93.8%** were **living at or below 250%** of the federal poverty level.

*Retention in care is based on data of People Living With HIV (PLWH) who had at least one outpatient ambulatory medical care (OAMC) visit by September 1 of the measurement year, with a second visit at least 90 days later.

**Viral suppression is based on data for PLWH who had at least one OAMC visit and at least one viral load test during the measurement year and whose most recent viral load test result was less than 200 copies/mL.
